PAPERWORK YOU WILL NEED TO PROVIDE

1. All players must provide proof of medical fitness dated **AFTER 1/1/2008**. Parents MUST complete the first page of the Pop Warner medical form. All participants must have their physician complete and sign the second page of the medical form, or get an alternative form from their doctor stating that they are able to participate in football/cheerleading (or that there is no restriction on activity). *Physical forms will not be accepted unless they explicitly state the child can participate in sports or has no restrictions on activity. If you have any questions about a form, ask now.*
2. First year players must provide an original birth certificate or certified copy with raised seal. This document will be needed before equipment will be issued, and will be returned after our paperwork has been certified by Hockomock League officials (the end of August). Passports, photocopies of a birth certificate stamped by a notary, and hospital certificates ("footprint certificates") are NOT acceptable. If you do not have an original or certified copy of your child's birth certificate, or are uncomfortable providing us with the original, certified copies can be obtained from the town offices of the town where your child was born. 3. A copy of your child's final report card. All participants must maintain a 70 or higher average across academic subjects to be eligible. Any participant at the D level or higher AND in 3rd grade or higher will be eligible for our Scholar Athlete Award if they maintain a 95 or higher average across academic subjects for the full school year.

EQUIPMENT WILL NOT BE ISSUED, AND CHILDREN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY KPPW/POP WARNER ACTIVITIES (INCLUDING PRACTICE) UNTIL ALL PAPERWORK HAS BEEN TURNED IN. THESE RULES HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED BY POP WARNER LITTLE SCHOLARS, OUR NATIONAL PARENT ORGANIZATION, AND MUST BE FOLLOWED STRICTLY. NO EXCEPTIONS CAN BE MADE.

A FEW NOTES FOR THE UPCOMING SEASON

- Paperwork night will tentatively be held on Thursday, June 26, 2008 in the cafeteria of the Delaney School on Taunton St. in Wrentham, from 6:30 PM to 7:30 PM. ALL outstanding paperwork must be turned in by that date.
- Equipment hand out will be done in late July. Dates/times will be posted on the web site.
- Practices will likely begin Monday, July 28th. As soon as it is finalized, the date will be posted on the web site.
- Master weigh-in for football players will be on Saturday, August 23rd, likely at Brockton High School. ALL football players must be weighed in. Football players not weighed in on this date will be ineligible for the first two games of the season.
- The 2008 season will begin on Labor Day weekend. Games could be held on Saturday, Sunday (if teams are traveling to the Cape), or Monday, depending on the opponent.
